Cash for Grass

Program Provisions and Restrictions

In order to participate in the Cash for Grass Program (Program), and in order to receive a rebate from the Upper Niobrara White Natural Resources District (NRD) as cost-share for sod installation, the following rules are applied:

- 1) All participating homeowners must have received a Letter of Approval *prior* to installation if cost-share is to be provided.
- 2) The Program will only consider lawns installed with Bowie® buffalograss sod purchased specifically from Niobrara Sod farm.
- 3) The Program will give preference to homeowners before commercial lawns are considered.
- 4) A participating homeowner will agree to both a pre- and post-installation inspection by the NRD.
- 5) If asked, participating homeowners will agree to post a small yard sign advertising the Cash for Grass Program. The sign will be supplied and posted at the discretion of the NRD for up to 90 days.
- 6) The new lawn cannot be replaced within five years.
- 7) The NRD is not responsible for site preparation, maintenance, or survival of the new lawn.
- 8) If a participating homeowner is found to have violated any of the above provisions and restrictions, the cost-share is voided and the homeowner is responsible for full repayment of the rebate. Furthermore, the homeowner will not be considered for future participation in the NRD's Cash for Grass Program.
